Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive in Tbilisi

Upon arrival in Tbilisi, the tour guide will meet you at the Airport. Transfer to the hotel, check in and overnight

Day 2 :- Tbilisi – Gori – Uplistsikhe – Borjomi - Bakuriani

After breakfast, depart with your guide to Gori to visit the Stalin Museum, including his birthplace and personal train. Continue to Uplistsikhe, an ancient rock-cut cave town. After lunch, proceed to Borjomi for a stroll in Central Park, famous for its mineral water, and enjoy a cable car ride. End the day in Bakuriani for dinner and overnight stay.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 3 :- Bakuriani – Vardzia – Akhatiskhe – Rabati Castle – Bakuriani

After breakfast, drive to Vardzia, an impressive 12th-century cave complex stretching 800 meters along the mountain, featuring over 600 rooms including monasteries, temples, and the Church of the Assumption. Continue to Akhaltsikhe to visit the restored 13th-century Rabati Fortress, located along the Potskhovi River. Return to Bakuriani for dinner and overnight stay.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 4 :- Bakuriani – Ananuri – Gudauri – Kazbegi

After breakfast, depart for Ananuri Fortress Complex, the former residence of the Argyveti Dukes, featuring 16th–17th century churches and towers overlooking the Jinali Reservoir. Continue to Gudauri, a mountain resort in the Caucasus, and stop at the Gudauri Friendship Monument (Treaty of Georgievsk Monument) to admire its panoramic views and Soviet-era mosaics. Proceed to Kazbegi for hotel check-in, dinner, and overnight stay.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 5 :- Kazbegi – Gergeti Trinity Church – Mtskheta – Jvari – Tbilisi

After breakfast, visit Gergeti Trinity Church, a 14th-century hilltop church set against the dramatic Caucasus landscape. Continue to Mtskheta, one of Georgia's oldest cities, to explore Svetitskhoveli Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site believed to house Christ's mantle. Visit the 6th-century Jvari Monastery, another UNESCO-listed landmark overlooking the confluence of two rivers. On the way to Tbilisi, stop at the Chronicles of Georgia, a towering monument depicting Georgia's history and biblical scenes. Arrive in Tbilisi for hotel check-in, followed by dinner at a traditional Georgian restaurant with a lively folk dancing show.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 6 :- Depart Tbilisi

After breakfast, enjoy a city tour of Tbilisi. Visit Metekhi Church and the monument to King Vakhtang Gorgasali, then head to Narikala Fortress for panoramic city views. Walk past the city's only mosque and explore the historic sulphur bath district and the charming Sharden area of Old Tbilisi. Continue to key landmarks including Sioni Cathedral, Anchiskhati Basilica, and the clock tower of Rezo Gabriadze Theatre. Cross the Bridge of Peace to Rike Park. After the tour, transfer to the airport for departure.
