Start your day with a delightful breakfast at the hotel. Then, embark on a private city tour, including visits to the Arena and Juliet's House. Verona, famed for the timeless love story of Romeo and Juliet, radiates romance. Its old town, encircled by medieval walls and the river Adige, forms a heart shape that enhances its allure. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Verona is celebrated for its blend of medieval and renaissance art, fine cuisine, and fashionable flair. As you wander through its picturesque streets, you'll discover the city's many treasures:

- The Arena: This famous Roman amphitheater, the third largest after the Colosseum, still hosts operas and cultural events.
- Via Mazzini: A bustling street connecting Piazza delle Erbe and Piazza Bra, ideal for shopping and admiring historic buildings.
- Piazza delle Erbe: A vibrant square rich in history, scents, and architectural marvels like Palazzo della Ragione, Case Mazzanti, Palazzo Maffei, and Casa dei Mercanti. The Madonna di Verona fountain stands at its center.
- Juliet's House: Adorned with love letters from around the world, this iconic site features the famous balcony where Romeo professed his love. Don't forget to take a photo with the statue of Juliet.
- Piazza dei Signori: An elegant square boasting a Renaissance loggia, several palaces, and the Tombs of the Scaligeri.

Day 5 :- Verona - Venice

Breakfast in hotel. Transfer to train station and board on a comfortable highspeed train to Venice. On arrival walk to your hotel, conveniently located at walking distance from train station. Overnight in Venice.

Day 6 :- Venice

Begin your day with a hearty breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, join a shared walking excursion (SIC) of Venice (entrance fees not included). This tour provides a unique exploration of Venice, starting with a walking tour that uncovers the city's hidden gems and picturesque spots around St. Mark's Square. Highlights of the walking tour include: St. Mark's Square: Admire the grandeur of St. Mark's Basilica, the elegant Doge's Palace, the Clock Tower, and the Procuratie (exterior views only). Campo Santa Maria Formosa: Discover this charming square and visit the Scuola Grande di San Marco, known as the "Great School of Charity." Malibran Theatre and the Mercerie: Stroll through this historic shopping district, once central to Venice's commercial life, connecting Rialto Bridge and St. Mark's Square. The second part of your tour features a scenic gondola ride through Venice's enchanting canals. Learn about the gondola's history and symbolism, including its multi-pronged ferro (prow) representing the six sestieri (districts) of Venice and its S-shape echoing the flow of the Canal Grande. Enjoy the captivating beauty of Venice from the water, with a gondola ride accommodating up to five people, guided by a local gondolier in a distinctive blue and white striped shirt. Board assistance is provided, but please note there is no commentary during the ride. End your day immersed in the magic of Venice. Overnight stay in Venice.
