### Tour Itinerary

#### Day 1 :- San Sebastian - Bilbao - Carranza

We will welcome you on the first day at 13:00 hours at the **Hotel Costa Vasca in San Sebastian** to start our route in the **Transcantabrico for 8 wonderful days**. Then we will get to know the main attractions of San Sebastian with a guided tour. At lunchtime, we will have an **exquisite lunch** in a downtown restaurant.
