## Day 1 :- Buenos Aires

## Day 2 :- Buenos Aires

After a relaxed start, gain a deeper understanding of Argentina’s identity as you explore the capital with your Travel Director. A guided walking tour takes you through key Argentina attractions, to see Plaza de Mayo and Casa Rosada, the presidential palace, before visiting the Metropolitan Cathedral. Then, immerse yourself in Argentina’s grilling culture for lunch at Fogón Asado. This immersive dining experience reimagines traditional parrilla cooking, with chefs preparing premium cuts over an open flame, right before your eyes – a contemporary take on one of Argentina’s most beloved culinary traditions. This reimagining of the traditional parrilla invites you to observe the techniques and traditions that shape Argentina’s approach to cooking. In San Telmo, experience an Insightful Encounter at El Viejo Almacén, one of the city’s oldest tango venues, where dancers bring this expressive art form to life.

## Day 3 :- Buenos Aires

Alternatively, step into the kitchen for a hands-on cooking class, where the estancia’s chef shares the secrets behind Argentina’s beloved empanadas.

## Day 4 :- Buenos Aires - Iguazu National Park

Fly north to the province of Misiones, where the subtropical rainforest meets one of South America’s greatest natural wonders. The Iguazú River plunges into a series of nearly 300 individual cascades, creating the awe-inspiring Iguazú Falls – wider than Victoria and taller than Niagara. As you arrive in Puerto Iguazú, glimpse the region’s rich biodiversity and striking red earth. On the way to your hotel, you’ll visit a forest-sheltered local market that supports sustainable producers and celebrates regional traditions. Here, enjoy an Insightful Encounter as you discover the story behind Argentina’s most iconic drink – mate, a herbal infusion made from the native yerba mate plant. Learn why this energising tea is more than a beverage – it’s a daily ritual and a symbol of hospitality across Argentina. ## Day 5 :- Iguazu National Park

Explore the Argentinian side of Iguazú Falls with your Local Expert, where a network of trails and walkways reveals the raw beauty of this UNESCO-listed site. Feel the spray on your skin as you approach the roaring Devil’s Throat, and witness the power of nature up close from multiple vantage points across the rainforest canopy and riverbanks. In the evening, visit a local finca for a dinner steeped in regional flavour. Set amid native forest, this rural hideaway showcases seasonal produce and time-honoured recipes, offering a relaxed and authentic taste of Misiones province under open skies.

## Day 6 :- Iguazu National Park - Rio de Janeiro

## Day 7 :- Rio de Janeiro

## Day 8 :- Rio de Janeiro

With your Local Expert, travel to the summit of Corcovado Mountain for a close look at Christ the Redeemer. Unveiled in 1931 after nearly a decade of construction, this monumental statue has become one of the most recognisable landmarks in the world. Learn how its design blends engineering innovation with national identity, and take in views across Rio's natural amphitheatre of sea, mountain and city: a highlight among the many unforgettable things to do in Brazil. Later, sit down to a traditional Brazilian barbecue at Assador Churrascaria. The rodízio dining style, where servers bring grilled meats directly to your table, reflects the country's long-standing love of communal meals. Located beside Guanabara Bay, the restaurant pairs classic dishes with one of Rio's most scenic settings.
