Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Antananarivo

Welcome to Madagascar! Upon clearing customs and immigration at Ivato International Airport in Antananarivo, you will be warmly greeted by your English-speaking private driver-guide. You will then board a luxury 4x4 vehicle for a smooth transfer to your premium hotel in the heart of the capital city. The remainder of the day is at your absolute leisure to check in, unpack, recover from your long-haul international flights, and enjoy the upscale facilities, spa, or swimming pool of the hotel.

Day 2 :- Antananarivo - Andasibe

After a hearty breakfast, check out from Novotel and begin your scenic journey eastward through the Highlands towards Andasibe, a drive of approximately 4.5 hours. Along the way, the landscape transforms from bustling cityscapes to terraced rice fields and lush, green hills. Your driver will stop at the vibrant transit town of Moramanga, where you will embark on a walking tour of the lively local market to witness daily Malagasy trade. Upon reaching your luxury forest lodge in Andasibe, check in and enjoy the peaceful surroundings. As darkness falls, gear up with your flashlights for an exciting guided Night Safari along the borders of the national park. Your specialized local guide will help you spot elusive nocturnal wildlife, including tiny mouse lemurs, sleeping chameleons, and unique tree frogs.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 3 :- Andasibe

Wake up early to the refreshing sounds of the rainforest for a full day of nature exploration. Your morning begins with a guided trek into the Analamazaotra Reserve, famous as the primary habitat of the Indri-Indri. This is the world's largest living lemur, renowned for its distinct, eerie siren-like communication calls that echo through the canopy. Next, venture deeper into the primary forest of Mantadia National Park, a pristine habitat where you can track rare lemur species like the Diademed Sifaka and observe the spectacular Parson's chameleon—the largest chameleon species on earth. Day 4 :- Andasibe - Antananarivo

After breakfast at the lodge, check out and begin your return drive back to the capital city, Antananarivo. Upon arrival in the afternoon, you will take a cultural excursion to the Royal Hill of Ambohimanga, a highly sacred UNESCO World Heritage site. This fortified historical complex contains the ancient palaces, royal tombs, and assembly areas of the Merina Kingdom, offering deep insights into Madagascar's pre-colonial history. A fascinating architectural detail is that its massive outer walls were constructed using a traditional mortar made from millions of egg whites! This evening, experience a true culinary highlight: an exclusive 6-Course Signature Tasting Dinner at Le Marais, an internationally acclaimed gastronomic restaurant run by the famous Malagasy Master Chef Lalaina, celebrating high-end local ingredients.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 5 :- Antananarivo - Morondava

Enjoy your breakfast before checking out of the hotel. Your driver will transfer you back to Ivato Airport to catch your scheduled Domestic Flight 1 flying westward across the island to the coastal town of Morondava. As you land on the warm west coast, a private transfer will escort you to your beautiful luxury beachfront resort facing the Mozambique Channel. After checking into your premium suite, take a relaxed afternoon walking tour with your guide to explore the bustling Bazary Be local market, where you can see coastal crafts, exotic fruits, and fresh catches, or choose to spend the rest of your day relaxing on the resort's sandy beach.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 6 :- Morondava (Kirindy & Baobab)

Today features an unforgettable journey into the rugged wild of western Madagascar. Board your 4x4 vehicle and drive through dry, sandy tracks into the deciduous Kirindy Forest Reserve. This unique eco-system is a prime sanctuary for viewing rare wildlife, most notably the Fosa—Madagascar's largest endemic mammal carnivore, which closely resembles a small cougar. You will also track giant jumping rats, various dry-forest lemurs, and exotic bird species. A fresh lunch will be served at the reserve's rustic forest restaurant. Late in the afternoon, drive to the world-famous Avenue of the Baobabs. Here, you will spend time walking among giant, 800-year-old Grandidier's Baobab trees and witness one of the most iconic sights in travel: the spectacular Madagascar sunset casting dramatic silhouettes of these ancient trees against a fiery orange sky.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 7 :- Morondava

Immerse yourself in a peaceful coastal culture experience today. You will board a traditional wooden Pirogue (a local outrigger dugout canoe) steered by a local fisherman. Glide gently through calm, scenic mangrove channels and coastal waters to reach the isolated settlement of Betania Village. This is a traditional community of the Vezo and Sakalava fishing tribes. Spend your morning walking through the village, interacting with the families, and learning about their ancient seafaring traditions, unique boat-building skills, and coastal way of life. For lunch, indulge in a memorable, Fresh Seafood Barbecue prepared right on the sandy beach, featuring freshly caught fish, crabs, or lobsters before paddling back to your resort for a relaxing evening.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 8 :- Morondava - Antananarivo

Bid farewell to the coast as you check out of the beachfront resort and transfer to Morondava Airport for your Domestic Flight 2 returning to Antananarivo. Upon landing back in the capital, your private driver will greet you. If your flight arrives before 12:00 PM, you will be taken on a complimentary Tana Free City Tour, highlighting the colonial architecture of the lower and upper towns, historic landmarks, and the old train station. The tour includes a stop at the famous La Digue Artisanal Craft Market, an open-air market showcasing thousands of local stalls, making it the perfect final stop to purchase authentic woodcarvings, spices, embroidered textiles, and souvenirs. Check back into your hotel for your final night.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 9 :- Antananarivo – Departure

Savour your final buffet breakfast at the hotel and take some time for last-minute packing. At the designated time, your private driver will provide a luxury transfer to Ivato International Airport. Remarks

Domestic Baggage Allowance: Passengers are strictly limited to one checked bag with a maximum weight of 20kg and one piece of hand luggage weighing up to 5kg for all domestic flights. Any excess weight charges must be paid directly by the clients at the check-in counter.

Personal Expenses for Meals: As lunch on Days 2, 4, 5, and 8 is not included in the package, clients must prepare sufficient cash (Euros or local currency Ariary) for these meals. Credit cards are generally not accepted in rural areas and local markets.
