Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Antananarivo

Upon touchdown at Ivato International Airport in Madagascar's historic capital, you will navigate visa formalities and be warmly welcomed by your private, English-speaking IndigoBe tour guide. You will be transferred via a private vehicle to your luxury hotel to check in and unwind. Later, enjoy a refreshing welcome cocktail alongside a comprehensive trip briefing to outline the upcoming stages of your journey, and receive a customized information pack along with a digital welcome kit.

Day 2 :- Antananarivo – Moramanga – Andasibe

After breakfast, depart the capital and drive eastward (140 km, +- 4h30) out of the highlands. The route transitions beautifully from geometric terraced rice paddies into dense, mist-shrouded tropical rainforests inhabited by the Bezanozano and Betsimisaraka ethnic groups. Along the highway, pass striking stands of ravinala (the traveler's tree), the proud national symbol of Madagascar. Stop for lunch in the historic town of Moramanga—a vital colonial crossroads and focal point of the 1947 Malagasy Uprising—where you will take a guided walk through its vibrant local market. Arrive at your luxury lodge for check-in. As night falls, gear up with headtorches for a thrilling night walking safari along the narrow trails of the private reserve. Your guide will point out endemic nocturnal wonders, including the minuscule mouse lemur (*Microcebus*), woolly lemurs (*Avahi*), sleeping chameleons, and colorful tree frogs.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 3 :- Andasibe & Mantadia National Parks

Set out very early after breakfast for a detailed 4-hour trekking expedition through the primary rainforest of Analamazaotra National Park. This wet, evergreen ecosystem is the premier sanctuary for tracking the iconic Indri-Indri, the largest living lemur on Earth, famous for its haunting, whale-like morning calls that echo through the canopy. Walk past giant tree ferns, wild orchids, and lianas while looking for chameleons and endemic birds. Following a scenic picnic lunch, continue your exploration in the adjacent Mantadia National Park. Spanning over 15,000 hectares, this dense primary forest offers prime opportunities to view highly endangered lemur species such as the Diademed Sifaka (*Propithecus diadema*) and Black-and-white Ruffed Lemur (*Varecia variegata*), as well as the magnificent Parson's chameleon (*Calumma parsonii*) and the bizarre giraffe weevil. Wrap up the afternoon with an immersive cultural walk through the small village of Andasibe to meet local Betsimisaraka residents and learn about their traditional forest-dependent lifestyle before returning to the comforts of the lodge.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 4 :- Andasibe – Ambohimanga – Antananarivo

Enjoy an early breakfast before checking out and beginning the drive back to Antananarivo (180 km, 5h30). Before re-entering the city, journey up to the historic Royal Hill of Ambohimanga (The Blue Hill), an invaluable UNESCO World Heritage Site. Serving as the cradle of the Merina Kingdom, this sacred citadel complex holds absolute spiritual and historical significance for the Malagasy people, remaining an active place of pilgrimage to this day. Tour the royal palace and necropolis, paying special attention to the massive exterior fortification walls which were constructed using a specialized lime plaster mixed with an incredible 16 million egg whites. Return to the capital to check in at your 5-star hotel. In the evening, you will be treated to an exclusive culinary experience at the world-renowned Le Marais restaurant. Indulge in an exquisite 6-course "Signature" gastronomic tasting menu curated by Chef Lalaina Ravelomanana—a member of the prestigious Académie Culinaire de France—where traditional French gastronomy seamlessly embraces Madagascar's finest local ingredients, such as wild pepper, organic vanilla, and premium Rova caviar.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 5 :- Antananarivo - Nosy Be

After breakfast, take a private transfer to Ivato Airport for your domestic flight over the island's interior to Fascene Airport on Nosy Be, famously known as the "Perfume Island". Upon arrival on this tropical slice of paradise, receive a warm welcome and transfer to your luxury wellness resort. Nestled amid aromatic plantations of Ylang-Ylang, frangipani, and coffee trees, Nosy Be represents a stunning marine complex surrounded by turquoise coral waters. Depending on your flight's arrival time, you can utilize the rest of the day to lounge on the sandy shores, dive into the resort's premium pool amenities, enjoy a therapeutic massage at the luxury wellness spa, or coordinate direct excursions to explore nearby landmarks like the spice markets of Hell-Ville or a sunset view from Mont Passot.

Day 6 :- Nosy Be - Nosy Tsarabanjina

Savor breakfast at the resort before checking out. At the designated time, board a high-speed motorboat for an unforgettable 1-hour and 35-minute sea crossing heading northeast into the remote Mitsio Archipelago. Your destination is the private island oasis of Nosy Tsarabanjina. As the boat approaches, watch the dramatic volcanic rock formations give way to blindingly white sands and untouched coral reefs. Land on the beach and check into your elite, ultra-private villa bungalow. Transition into an upscale, worry-free paradise environment with an All-Inclusive stay structure that takes care of every drink, meal, and standard amenity, allowing you to settle into island time completely detached from the outside world.

Day 7 :- Nosy Tsarabanjina Island

You can spend your hours snorkeling through crystal-clear waters directly from the beach to look for sea turtles, beachcombing the powdery shoreline, hiking the island's lush interior trails to discover rare birds, or enjoying a premium signature massage right by the ocean waves.

Day 8 :- Nosy Tsarabanjina - Nosy Be - Antananarivo

Following breakfast on the island, board the morning speedboat return transfer to Nosy Be to connect with your domestic flight back to Antananarivo. Upon arrival in the capital, receive an English-speaking welcome and transfer to your hotel. If your domestic flight lands before 12:00 PM, you will enjoy a complimentary "Tanà Free Tour," which features an extensive visit to the sprawling La Digue Handicraft Market. This open-air market is one of the largest artisan crafts assemblies in Africa, offering thousands of stalls of handwrought woodcarvings, fine embroidery, and local spices. Follow this with a panoramic city tour exploring historical monuments, the iconic Soarano Train Station, and the bustling Avenue de l'Indépendance. (Note: If the flight lands between 12:00 PM and 4:00 PM, the tour will focus exclusively on the La Digue market). Conclude the day with a farewell group dinner at the hotel restaurant.

Day 9 :- Antananarivo – Departure

Share a final breakfast at your hotel before checking out. At the scheduled time matching your flight schedule, your private vehicle and guide will transfer you back to Ivato International Airport to check in for your international return flight home, bringing an extraordinary luxury journey across Madagascar to a memorable close.
