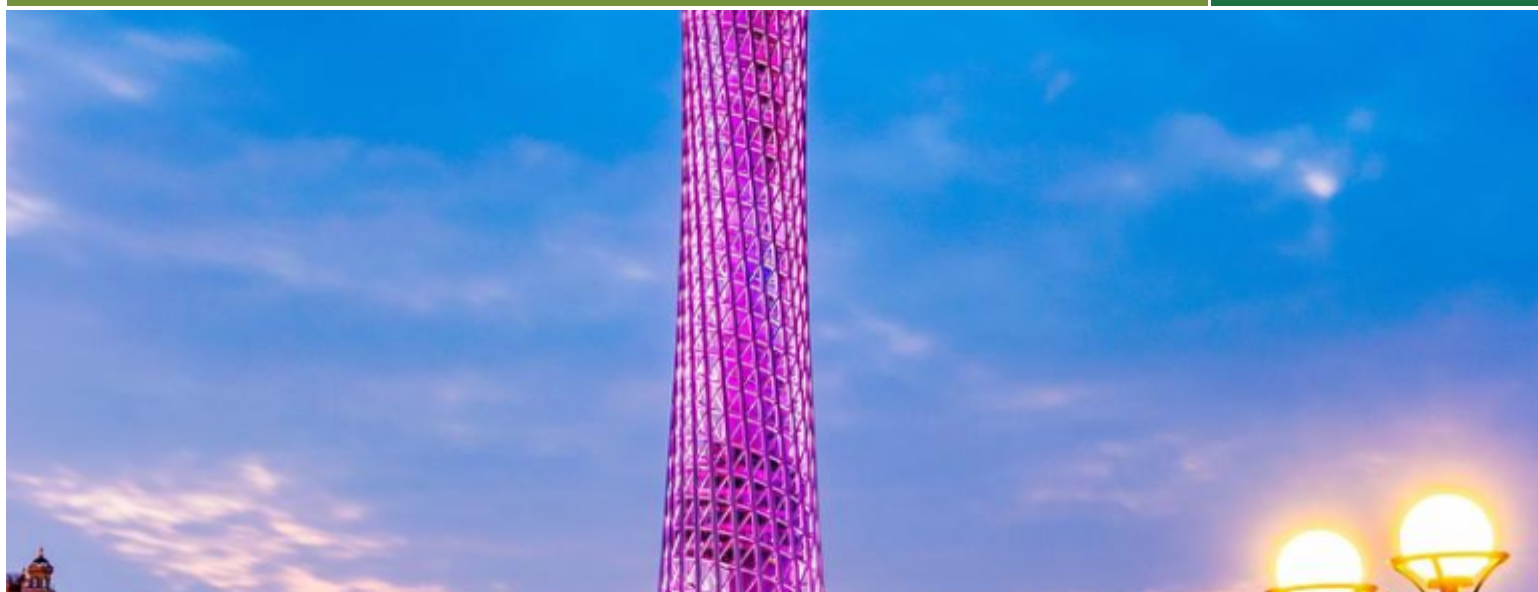

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Guangzhou

Upon arrival Guangzhou Airport, meet and greet at the airport. Transfer to hotel for check in. Overnight in Guangzhou.

Day 2 :- Guangzhou

After breakfast, proceed to Future Technology Island and Huacheng Square to explore six themed technology zones, where you can interact with a robot dog, watch robot football, try an exoskeleton, or experience a low-altitude flight simulator (optional and subject to availability). Continue with a driverless shuttle bus tour around the island before visiting the GAC Pavilion to discover the latest electric vehicle innovations. Next, stroll through Yongqing Fang, a revitalized historical district showcasing traditional Lingnan architecture, heritage buildings, boutique shops, and local arts. Then, visit New Lychee Bay to enjoy its peaceful canals, historic bridges, and charming old-world atmosphere. End the day at Shangxiajiu Pedestrian Street, a lively shopping destination lined with traditional Cantonese-style arcades, local snack shops, and a variety of retail stores before overnight in Guangzhou.

Breakfast

Day 3 :- Guangzhou - Meizhou (By High-Speed Train 4 Hours)

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Guangzhou Railway Station and board the high-speed train to Meizhou. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel for check-in before visiting Qianfo Pagoda, a renowned Buddhist landmark known for its beautiful architecture and tranquil surroundings. Continue to Weilong House, a traditional Hakka-style circular residence that reflects the unique culture and heritage of the Hakka people. End the day with a stroll along Jiangbei Old Street, a charming historic street lined with traditional shops, local delicacies, and a nostalgic old-town atmosphere before overnight in Meizhou.

Breakfast

Day 4 :- Meizhou - Gaopi (2.5 Hours) - Meizhou

After breakfast at the hotel, visit the former residences of Lee Kuan Yew and Tian Jiabing, both reflecting the rich historical and cultural heritage of the region. Continue to the Gaopi Ceramics Cultural Historic District to explore the area’s traditional ceramic craftsmanship and cultural legacy. Next, head to Songkou Ancient Town, often referred to as the “Little Phoenix of Guangdong,” where you can stroll through its ancient streets and admire traces of its prosperous past. Explore Songkou Old Street and Fireboat Wharf, once known as “Little Hong Kong” for its thriving trading history, before visiting Meidong Bridge to enjoy panoramic views of Songkou Ancient Town, a former commercial hub in eastern Guangdong renowned for its rich heritage. Overnight in Meizhou.

Breakfast

Day 5 :- Meizhou

After breakfast, visit Qiaoxi Village, including an electric cart ride, to explore this ancient Hakka village often described as a “dreamlike Hakka landscape.” Continue to the Hakka Museum (closed on Mondays) to gain a deeper understanding of Hakka culture, followed by a visit to the former residence of Ye Jianying, which offers insight into the life of the renowned military leader and China’s revolutionary history. Overnight in Meizhou.

Breakfast

Day 6 :- Meizhou - Guangzhou (By High-Speed Train 4 Hours)

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Meizhou Railway Station and board the high-speed train to Guangzhou. Upon arrival, begin your city tour with a visit to Dafo Temple, a historic Buddhist temple located in the heart of the city, before exploring Beijing Road Pedestrian Street, one of Guangzhou’s most popular shopping and entertainment districts, renowned for its vibrant atmosphere, local delicacies, and retail outlets. Overnight in Guangzhou.

Breakfast

Day 7 :- Guangzhou

After breakfast at the hotel, proceed to Foshan and visit XPENG Technology Park to explore the latest innovations in smart mobility, electric vehicles, and autonomous driving. Continue to the Nanyue King Museum and the Chen Clan Ancestral Hall to discover Guangzhou’s rich history and traditional Lingnan architecture. End the day with shopping and leisure at Fashion Tianhe and Parc Central before overnight in Guangzhou.

Breakfast

Day 8 :- Guangzhou - Panyu - Guangzhou

After breakfast at the hotel, proceed to Panyu and visit Baomo Garden, a picturesque Lingnan-style garden renowned for its classical architecture and serene landscapes. Continue to Shawan Ancient Town to explore its rich Cantonese heritage, followed by Yuyin Shanfang, one of Guangdong’s finest classical gardens. End the day at Xifang Courtyard and Dream Space Library, where heritage architecture meets modern creativity, before overnight in Guangzhou.

Day 9 :- Departure Guangzhou

After breakfast at hotel and check-out, free at your own leisure until transfer time to airport for your departure.
