Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive in Entebbe, Uganda

Welcome to Entebbe, surrounded by the Ziki Forest near the shores of Lake Victoria. Hotel rooms are available for mid-afternoon check-in.

Day 2 :- Entebbe - Kihiki - Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

After breakfast, board your flight to Kihiki, where you'll be met on arrival and transferred to your lodge near Bwindi Impenetrable National Park—a UNESCO World Heritage Site and your base for gorilla trekking. Following lunch at the lodge, set out on a guided nature walk through lush gardens overlooking the Munyanga River.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 3 :- Bwindi Impenetrable National Park (Mountain Gorilla Trekking)

This morning, gather for an insightful briefing from expert rangers before setting out on your unforgettable gorilla trek. Accompanied by skilled trackers, journey through the dense rainforest in search of one of Bwindi's gorilla families. Once located, enjoy a full hour quietly observing them as they eat, groom, and play.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 4 :- Bwindi - Kihiki - Entebbe - Fly to Nairobi, Kenya

This morning, return to Kihiki for your flight to Entebbe, connecting onward to Nairobi. Arrive in Nairobi by mid-afternoon with the remainder of the day free to relax and unwind.

Day 5 :- Nairobi Sightseeing

Guided sightseeing starts with a morning game drive in Nairobi National Park. Then visit Sheldrick Wildlife Trust to learn about elephant conservation. Visit Karen Blixen Museum, dedicated to the author of Out of Africa, enjoy lunch in the gardens, and visit the Giraffe Centre.

Breakfast Lunch

Day 6 :- Nairobi - Ol Pejeta Conservancy

Drive north to Ol Pejeta Conservancy, the largest rhino sanctuary in East Africa. Embark on an afternoon game drive in search of the "Big 5" and conclude with an exclusive welcome bush barbecue dinner.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 7 :- Ol Pejeta Conservancy

Rise early for a morning game drive with Mount Kenya as the backdrop. After lunch, visit the Sweetwaters Chimpanzee Sanctuary followed by an afternoon game drive.

Day 8 :- Ol Pejeta - Nyahururu Falls - Lake Nakuru National Park

Journey through the Kenyan highlands, stop at dramatic Nyahururu Falls, and arrive at Lake Nakuru National Park for an afternoon game drive amidst the largest euphorbia forest in Africa.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 9 :- Lake Nakuru - Maasai Mara National Reserve

Depart for Kenya's most famous game reserve, the Maasai Mara. After lunch at your lodge, set out on an afternoon game drive. Enjoy a garden-fresh farm-to-table dinner tonight.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 10 :- Maasai Mara National Reserve

Early morning game drive including an exclusive bush breakfast in the wild. Return to camp to relax before embarking on your afternoon game drive.

Day 11 :- Maasai Mara - Amboseli National Park

Fly to Amboseli National Park, renowned for spectacular views of Mount Kilimanjaro. Enjoy lunch at the lodge followed by an afternoon game drive.

Day 12 :- Amboseli National Park

Morning and afternoon game drives in Amboseli to view massive elephant herds. Visit a traditional Maasai village and stop for scenic sundowner drinks.

Day 13 :- Amboseli - Namanga Border - Arusha, Tanzania - Lake Manyara National Park

Cross into Tanzania at Namanga, enjoy lunch at Arusha's largest coffee plantation, and drive along the Great Rift Valley escarpment to your safari lodge.

Day 14 :- Lake Manyara - Karatu - Ngorongoro Conservation Area

Morning game drive in Lake Manyara National Park. After lunch, visit a local primary school in Karatu and continue to your lodge on the rim of Ngorongoro Crater.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 15 :- Ngorongoro Crater

Descend into the crater for a full-day game drive in the world's largest unflooded caldera with an exclusive bush lunch. Tonight, enjoy a traditional Maasai dance performance.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 16 :- Ngorongoro - Serengeti National Park

Drive to Serengeti National Park and enjoy lunch at your tented camp before an afternoon game drive searching for big cats across the boundless savannah.

Day 17 :- Serengeti National Park

Morning and afternoon game drives exploring the prime wildlife corridors of the Serengeti. Tonight, join a celebratory farewell bush dinner under the stars.

Remarks & Safety

- All game viewing is conducted at your own risk and requires a signed liability waiver prior to travel.
- Due to rough terrain on and off-road between game reserves, this tour is not recommended for travelers with severe back or mobility conditions.
- Safari vehicles are customized 4WD vehicles designed for rough African terrain with high ground clearance.

Gorilla Trekking Guidelines

- Mountain gorilla trekking in Bwindi Impenetrable National Park involves 2 to 7 hours of hiking across steep, rugged rainforest terrain at altitudes up to 2,600m.
- Moderate to good physical fitness is required.
- Minimum age for gorilla trekking permits is 15 years.
- Direct viewing time with gorilla families is strictly limited to 1 hour to protect wildlife.

Flight & Luggage Restrictions

- Internal bush flights strictly enforce a maximum baggage limit of 15 kg (33 lbs) per traveler in soft-sided bags.
- Hard suitcases and wheeled luggage with rigid frames are not permitted on internal bush aircraft.

Visa & Entry Requirements

- Entry visas are required for Uganda, Kenya, and Tanzania.
- The East Africa Tourist Visa covers entry to both Uganda and Kenya.
- Passports must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the departure date with at least 4 blank visa pages.

Health & Vaccinations

- Yellow Fever vaccination certificate is mandatory for all travelers entering Uganda, Kenya, and Tanzania.
- Malaria prophylaxis is strongly advised for all safari destinations.
